

## **BURNING PERMITS**

The Town of Mishicot issues burning permits. Residents must follow DNR-prescribed rules regarding open burning.

The following link, <u>https://dnr.wisconsin.gov/topic/OpenBurning</u> contains helpful information from the Department of Natural Resources regarding what type of burning is legal in Wisconsin.

Burning permits can be obtained from the Town Board Chairperson, the Town Board Supervisors, and the Town Road Superintendent. (please insert a link here to the contact page).

If you are not burning on the day the permit is issued, it is your responsibility to make sure you are not burning in a high risk situation such as high winds or overly dry conditions.

It is recommended that you contact the non-emergency number of the Manitowoc County Sheriff's Department 920-683-4200, particularly in the case of larger burns, to let them know of your burning activity. This is important in the event a passer-by reports a fire to their department.
