-  **Etc.**

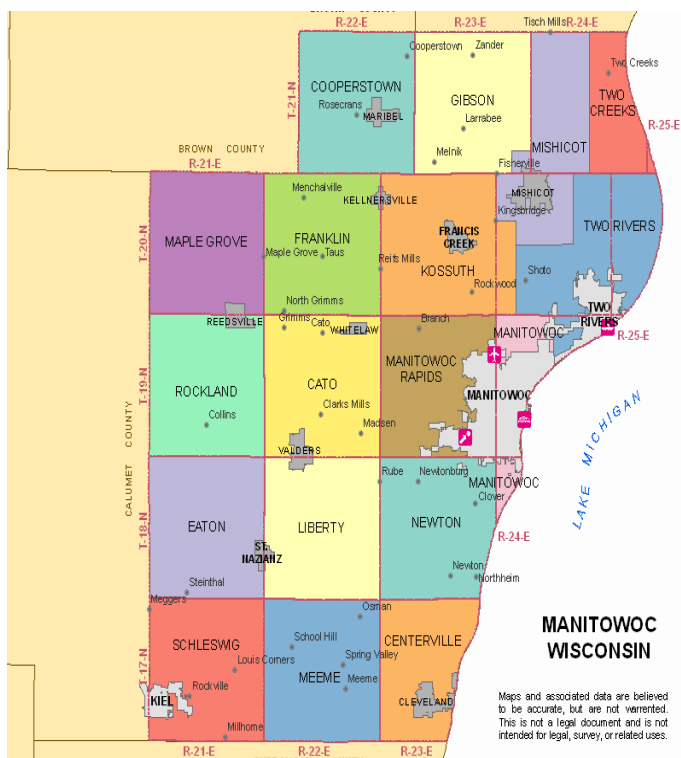
**Cost: \$6 round-trip/unlimited stops**  
**Non-Scheduled day trip cost is only \$12**  
**\* 2-5 riders required per trip**

The ADRC also provides Out-Of-County medical transportation services. Elderly and/or disabled individuals who qualify to utilize this program pay only the current IRS mileage reimbursement rate. *The 2016 mileage rate is just \$0.54 per mile.*
