Special Meeting of the Town Board

A special meeting of the Mishicot Town Board was held at the Town Hall, 710 N. State St., Mishicot, on Monday, September 8, 2025 at 4:30 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chairperson Anhalt called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance followed. In attendance for the board were Dean Anhalt, Lee Stefaniak, Gordon Augustine, Dean LeCaptain, and Connie Tesarik. E. Assman Road resident Al Biely was also present.

DISCUSSION AND ACTION REGARDING PLANS TO OPEN THE E. ASSMAN ROAD AND BRIDGE

Chairman Anhalt has been preparing to gather materials and information in order to properly and safely reopen the E. Assman Road and bridge. It has been determined that the center of the bridge is safe to open as one lane with a 30-ton weight limit. Mr. Anhalt has located guardrails that will come from Manitowoc County. He will secure concrete bunkers/blocks, probably three on each side, from Carew. The board also went through the sign inventory to determine which signs and posts will still need to be purchased. Guardrails, bunkers, and signs will be used to guide traffic to one lane over the bridge, warn of traffic changes ahead, weight and width restrictions, and road work ahead. Signs will be necessary from both sides of the bridge.

Mike Koeppel may be able to haul the concrete bunkers/blocks from Carew to the bridge. Joe Heyroth could also possibly assist with moving the blocks at the bridge. Mr. Anhalt will get the signs on order. Supervisor Stefaniak will talk to Mike Koeppel to see if he would be available to move the blocks in a week or two. Mr. Anhalt will contact Manitowoc County about obtaining guardrails. It is hoped that the road and bridge reopening could occur within one month.

Chairman Anhalt also discussed cutting trees on E. Assman since the road is closed. He would like to contact the landowners to discuss the cutting beforehand.

ADJOURN

Supervisor Stefaniak moved to adjourn the meeting at 5:25 p.m. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Augustine. All votes in favor. Motion carried.
