

MINUTES OF EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE MISHICOT TOWN BOARD

Wednesday, April 15, 2026, Mishicot Town Hall
710 N. State Street, Mishicot, Wisconsin

Due to the amount of flooding from this week's storms, the town board of the Town of Mishicot met on Wednesday, April 15, 2026, at 4:00 p.m. at the Mishicot Town Hall, 710 N. State Street, Mishicot, Wisconsin, to discuss flood damage and to develop a plan of action.

Chairman Anhalt called the meeting of the board to order at 4:00 p.m. Present for the board were Dean Anhalt, Lee Stefaniak, Gordon Augustine, Dean LeCaptain, and Connie Tesarik.

Tom Lambert has agreed to help with any flood issues.

Assman Road has several washouts. One inquiry was made by Madeline Rathgaber, 2020 Assman Road, that the driveway and shoulder have washed out and was concerned about the mailman getting hung up there. There are washouts along Assman Road, including by Schaus. There is a big hole by Paplham. One suggestion was to have Lambert dump gravel at Paplham's and work from there, or it could be dumped at the hall and work from here. Supervisor Augustine suggested using ground that is already at the hall. Lambert could dump the gravel in the Paplham driveway or in the area of Assman Road. Crevices should be filled by the Assman Bridge as well. Tom Lambert should look at it since the reach is far.

Dean LeCaptain was asked to take a look at Saxonburg by Skubal's. Everything is OK so far by Madden on Zander Road. Chairman Anhalt gave Dean LeCaptain permission to do whatever he needs to do to fix things up. He should also pull gravel back onto Paplham's driveway.

On Assman by Pekarek, the road is half gone. It could cost \$4-\$6,000 to do a hydraulic study. If it shows that the culvert cannot handle it, we may need a bigger pipe and would be able to get 50/50 bridge aid. We could add a second pipe, but that would interfere with bridge aid. A new pipe could be \$50-\$60,000 or as much as \$80,000. Supervisor Stefaniak said he would like to see a bigger pipe there. The original pipe was put in about 1984 or 1985. Chairman Anhalt will reach out to Rich Glen and see what we have there and then 2-3 sizes bigger to see what that would cost, including the hydraulic study.

Motion was made by Lee Stefaniak to adjourn the meeting. Motion seconded by Supervisor Augustine. Meeting adjourned at 5:00 p.m. All votes in favor. Motion carried.
